Chairman's Report

I hope by the time you receive this annual report we will have finally emerged from what seems to have been a very long winter. Let us hope that spring lifts our spirits and summer affords us warm sunny happy days.

The past 12 months seem to have gone by in a flash although they have been full of behind the scenes work, particularly for Catherine, our dedicated parish clerk. Government and local authority directives and requirements generate a lot of work even for a small parish such as ours. New legislation concerning 'data protection' is causing enormous problems even to the smallest task. Any communication from one of you MEANS WE HOLD DATA and records as to how it is held and by whom ie one or all of the councillors has to be recorded.

We have recently had to give the parish opinion on a 150-question consultation regarding the Greater Norwich Local Plan up until 2036. This questionnaire alone constituted hours of reading for your parish councillors and clerk, digesting its implications for the residents of this parish, South Norfolk and the wider area.

I expect most of you will have seen the "village gates" that have been erected so far, we are pressing for the completion of this project.

Better broadband is another issue that your parish council is pursuing on your behalf. We have looked at WiSpire and ITSwisp and even discussed the possibility of installing fibre optic cables ourselves as some other rural communities have done. It would seem we are on BT's (Openreach) 'no plans to upgrade' list, so we will continue to look at all the up to date options for Kimberley and Carlton Forehoe and report back with cost and logistic implications.

Finally, we have changed our website address to <u>www.kimberleyandcarletonforehoe.org.uk</u> – pop along and see what is new there. The site is regularly updated, including details of forthcoming meetings.

Thanks to all our parish councillors and Catherine Moore for their continued efforts on behalf of both communities. Also my special thanks personally to them all during a difficult period last autumn.
