It is hard to believe that the time to write another report has come around again!

Upon reading last year's report I am reminded that the community emergency plan has been on our agenda for 12 months. If you recall, the Parish Council had asked if there was a volunteer to act as a second co-ordinator but unfortunately we did not receive any response. However I am pleased and grateful to Joy Smiley for stepping up to the plate. Joy and I attended a meeting at South Norfolk District Council offices in Autumn 2016 to discuss format and requirements. Since then a number of changes have resulted in the questionnaire enclosed with this report. It would be fantastic if we can receive a 100% feedback so that every household's needs and potential contribution in the event of an emergency can be on record.

During 2016 a number of traffic accidents occurred on the B1135 within the approach to Kimberley. I understand that on two occasions vehicles ended up in the hedge. Your parish council arranged a meeting with a highways engineer to determine what could be done to persuade motorists to slow down and take better care. You may have noticed that reflective marker posts have already been installed on the right hand bend opposite School Lodge. 40mph road surface roundalls are to be added this summer. In addition your PC had already applied for funding to have 'village gates' installed on Kimberley boundaries. These are the white paling structures often seen at the approach to many villages particularly in Suffolk. I am pleased to report that we were successful and the 'village gates' are due to be installed in the coming months, subject to final funding for the scheme.

Once again, our collective thanks to Joy, Jane, Diana, Val and of course our very knowledgeable clerk, Catherine for their continuing efforts on your behalf.

I hope that you will all continue to enjoy living in the special piece of Norfolk that is Kimberley and Carleton Forehoe.
