## Chairman's Report

As one of the county's smallest Parish Councils, it is understandable that we have little to consider that is of national importance; however the commitment of your elected representatives remains steadfast, attending meetings throughout the year at Kimberley and Carleton Forehoe parish churches and at other venues within the county. Their dedication together with that of Parish Clerk Catherine Moore ensures that our resident's voices are heard by the appropriate bodies whenever necessary.

During the year, two issues have dominated our parish meetings. First, the disregard by some road users of the 40mph speed limit and the potential danger at our road junctions. This is even more evident as the volume of traffic continues to increase year on year. We have successfully lobbied for some recent speed monitoring and are hoping to carry out extra surveillance by local volunteers using some loan equipment.

The second issue is the continued flooding of the unmade road on The Green in Kimberley. Although adjacent flooding on the B1108 has been cured by the installation of an overflow pipe, the subsequent reinstatement of the unmade road has been less than satisfactory. The Parish Council has **repeatedly** argued the case but so far have been refused a solution. This lobbying will continue. Looking forward, the Parish Council has commissioned a restoration of the village sign in Kimberley, following a generous grant of £1,000 by the Kimberley Fete Committee. The Council is actively looking at issues around drainage on The Green in Kimberley and will be digging some water grups into the green to allow water run off. The situation will be monitored.

The Council is working with Carleton Forehoe Fenland Trust to find a solution to their problem of public liability insurance. Options are being explored and will be discussed at future meetings.

Finally, we reported last year that we would be applying for Quality Status, however with suspension of the scheme pending a review, this has been put on hold and will be pursued once details of the new scheme are published.
