Chairman's Report

My end of year report for 2011/12 reflects one of the most successful years for your parish council. After many years of constant lobbying we have finally achieved a 40mph speed limit through Kimberley. This is no mean feat given the reluctance of relevant principal authorities to reduce from 50mph.

Also the drainage scheme to alleviate flooding on the B1108 adjacent to Green Farm has succeeded in its primary aim, although the flooding along the unmade road on The Green has yet to be resolved. The Parish Council continues to negotiate an acceptable resolution on behalf of our parishioners.

A number of planning applications were dealt with throughout the year as were any statutory items that came before us.

My thanks go to Catherine once again for her invaluable assistance to myself and all the Parish Councillors. Her depth of knowledge and efficient manner is a credit to her and a gift to us. My thanks also to my fellow parish councillors for their dedication and hard work and especially to Joy Smiley for chairing meetings when I was unable to attend.

Future Plans

For 2012, the Parish Council have a number of schemes underway. Thanks to a grant from the South Norfolk Council Neighbourhood Board, the notice board in Carleton Forehoe will be replaced with a new version to match the board in Kimberley. The Parish Council also plans to plant a tree on Kimberley Green to commemorate the Queen's Diamond Jubilee.

The village sign in Kimberley is in need of repair, and quotations are being sought with a view to gaining grant funding to repair this. The ongoing problem of flooding on Kimberley Green remains on the agenda and a resolution to this issue is being discussed with the relevant authorities.

Finally, the Parish Council seeks to attain Quality Status by the end of 2012 – watch this space for further news!
