8. PLANNING

8.1 Applications for consideration

2017/1113 & 1114 7 The Green, Kimberley: Proposed rear extension. Councillors considered the application, which had arrived after the agenda was published. The application was for a large extension, and included proposals to open a bed and breakfast. Councillors agreed that they were not opposed to the extension, however the business element was of concern. The application suggested two letting bedrooms, which was likely to result in two additional cars. Parking was already a problem in The Green, and the Clerk was asked to confirm Clerk with South Norfolk Council whether they allowed parking on The Green. It was anticipated that this additional occupancy would result in more vehicle movements including cars accessing the property, oil deliveries, and septic tank emptying. This would result in additional wear and tear on the road, which would have to be borne by all 8 stakeholders. The Parish Council wished to see a change of use application be required as 66% of the building would be used as a B&B. It was **agreed** that the Clerk Clerk would ask South Norfolk Council whether a change of use application would be required, and whether and application would be required for lamp posts in the conservation area. The ownership and parking arrangements on The Green would be confirmed. It was agreed that the Vice Chairman and the Clerk would be VCH / delegated to formulate the Council's response to the application. Clerk

Michael Edney confirmed that no parishes would be compelled to out in new arrangements against their will. It was **agreed** that the Council would respond stating simply that they wished to remain as they were, and that if alternative arrangements were proposed at a later date, a more robust defence would be submitted, proposed by Jane Fraser, seconded by Joy Smiley, all in favour.
