Chairman's Report

It's been another successful year for the Parish Council. In May, all five councillors were re-elected – we were one of the few councils to fill all of the available seats.

In July 2015 we were proud to receive the Local Council Award Scheme 'Foundation' Award. This recognises that the Parish Council is a well-performing council which meets the minimum statutory standards.

In February 2016 we were exceptionally pleased to have the vehicle activated signs installed on Norwich Road, made possible by 50/50 funding with Norfolk County Council. Since the speed activated signs were made operational I hope the residents of Kimberley have noticed more motorists on the B1108 abiding by the 40mph speed limit.

Personally I have followed a number of motorists that clearly apply their brakes when the sign flashes in their face! Obviously there are those who choose to ignore the limit. Therefore your parish council will continue to press the police speed awareness team to continue monitoring the road throughout the year. As stated in my May 2015 report, obtaining the signs was only made possible with donations from the village fete fund and generous contributions from a number of our residents. Therefore, can I express many thanks on behalf of the parish council to those who helped make this project possible. I was pleased that once again we managed to set a balanced budget without any increase in the precept – the Parish Council's share of the council tax.

A new project on the horizon is the Community Emergency Plan. Working in conjunction with South Norfolk Council, the CEP allows parish to make a formal emergency plan so that, should the worst happen, people in the community can summon swift help and assist our vulnerable residents through the lists within the Plan. Before we can progress this, we need a second co-ordinator — it's not onerous, but could make such a difference if the plan had to be activated. Please contact the Clerk if you are able to help.

Finally, many thanks on behalf of the parish residents to Joy, Jane, Diana and Val for their time and efforts throughout the year and once again appreciation and thanks to Catherine for her dedication and expert input, all of which keeps Kimberley and Carleton Forehoe flying an independent flag.
